### Objective: To contribute to the development of qualitative local public services in Libya

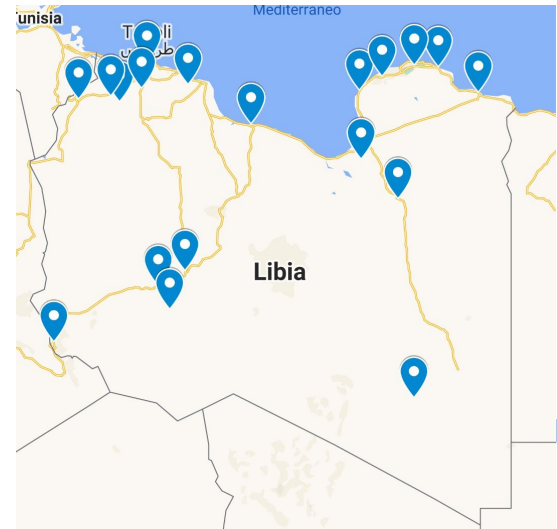
- National and international cooperation of Libyan municipalities on **environment, youth, social and health** as well as **communication** services is improved

# TAMSALL main performed activities

---

Establishment of the **local team**:

- some members have past experience in administration and politics at local level
- some members have solid experience with working with international donors' projects
- team members distributed all over Libya - antennas on the territories

**Training for City Managers** on **multi-level, multi-stakeholder approach** in planning and implementing services

**Assessment** of municipalities' capacity of delivering services and **benchmarking** of municipalities against their use of a multi-level and multi-stakeholder approach in planning and implementing services (TAMSALL questionnaire)



# TAMSALL main future activities

---

**5 Workshops in Libya** for TAMSALL municipalities' officers and stakeholders, on

- the multilevel governance (MLG) approach
- Emilia-Romagna and Friuli Venezia-Giulia experiences with MLG
- results of TAMSALL benchmarking process

**Traineeship visits in Italy** for 72 representatives of TAMSALL municipalities, for sharing the culture, tools and practices of Italian decentralization process with our Libyan counterparts

**Capacity building exercises** on the ground involving the municipalities and their stakeholders

**Pilot actions** in some of TAMSALL municipalities, but to be modeled and replicated
